

## Making a Straight Highway for our God

People like straight highways. They are quicker, safer and more pleasant.

In the prophecy of Isaiah, a voice cries out, 'In the desert prepare a way for the Lord!' John the Baptist quoted this passage to prepare people for the coming of Jesus.

During Advent we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ in our lives. In the past we formed habits as sturdy as two-lane roads. They got us where we wanted to go, but sometimes not by the most direct route.

We have only a couple of weeks till Christmas. It is time to move the roadblocks and detours that keep us from encountering Christ.

Hardness of heart, stinginess of time, or unbending habits: which of these need repair on your highway towards Christ?



1<sup>st</sup> Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5,9-11

Response: **Let us see, O Lord, your mercy, and give us your saving help.**

2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: 2 Peter 3:8-14

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

**Entrance Antiphon:** O people of Sion, behold, the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart.

**Gospel Acclamation:** Alleluia, alleluia! Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight, and all mankind shall see the salvation of God. Alleluia!

**Church Cleaning:**

**Wednesday 13 December: St Lucy, Virgin & Martyr**

Lucy suffered martyrdom at Syracuse, probably during the persecution of Diocletian. Her name, meaning 'light', makes her a perfect Advent saint. Christian art depicts her holding her eyes. According to one legend her tormentors removed her eyes. Devotion to her spread almost throughout the whole Church and dates back to the earliest times.

**Thursday 14 December: St John of the Cross**

St John of the Cross, born at Fontiveros in Old Castile (Spain) about the year 1542, was a Carmelite friar, mystic and poet. A Carmelite reformer, he befriended St Teresa

of Avila. He was outstanding in holiness and wisdom, as his spiritual writings testify.

**Friday 15 December: Rosary at 7pm.**

The Holy Rosary is recited in the church at 7pm every Friday. All are welcome.

**Sunday 24 December: Morning Masses at 9am & 11am as normal.**


*Christmas Eve Vigil Mass with Nativity Play at 6.30pm.*
