'A poor Church for the poor'

In today's Gospel, Jesus doesn't just say, "Blessed are the poor", but rather, "Blessed are *you* who are poor". He is speaking to His disciples, so we understand that it is not poverty in itself that is blessed, but the poverty of those who follow Him, who love God, and who love their neighbour. Together we are called to be, as Pope Francis puts it, a poor Church for the poor.
